

JESUS SAID, “Not everyone who says to me, Lord, Lord, will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he who does the will of my **FATHER** who is in heaven. Many will say to me on that day, Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and in your name drive out demons and perform many miracles? **Then I will tell them plainly, I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!**”

Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock. **But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash.**” (Matthew 7:21-27)

“He who does not love me will not obey my teaching. **These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the **FATHER** who sent me.**” (John 14:24)

“Whosoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. **He who loves me will be loved of my **FATHER**, and I too will love him and show myself to him.**” (John 14:21)

“Jesus replied, **If anyone loves me, he will obey my teaching. My **FATHER** will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.**” (John 14:23)

“Yet a time is coming and has now come **when the true worshipers will worship the **FATHER** in spirit and truth, for they are the kind of worshipers **the **FATHER** seeks. **GOD** is a Spirit, and **HIS** worshipers must worship in spirit and in truth.**”** (John 4:23-24)

“In that day you will no longer ask me anything. **I tell you the truth, my **FATHER** will give you whatever you ask in my name. **Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. **Ask and you will receive, and your joy will be complete.** Though I have been speaking figuratively, a time is coming when I will no longer use this kind of language but will tell you plainly about the **FATHER**. **In that day you will ask in my name. I am not saying that I will ask the **FATHER** on your behalf. **No, the **FATHER HIMSELF** loves you because you have loved me and have believed that I came from **GOD**. **I came from the **FATHER** and entered the world; now I am leaving the world and going back to the **FATHER**.**”******** (John 16:23-28)

“But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and **pray to your **FATHER**, who is unseen. **Then your **FATHER**, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.** And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, **for your **FATHER** knows what you need before you ask **HIM**.** This, then, is how you should pray: **Our **FATHER** in heaven, hallowed be **YOUR** name, **YOUR** kingdom come, **YOUR** will be done on earth as it is in heaven. **Give us today our daily bread. **Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. **And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.**”******** (Matthew 6:6-13) [They left out, “**For **THINE** is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. **Amen**”** in verse 13 (KJV)]

“Jesus said unto them, **If **GOD** were your **FATHER**, you would love me, for I came from **GOD** and now am here. **I have not come on my own; but **HE** sent me.**”** (John 8:42)

“Jesus answered, **My teaching is not my own. It comes from **HIM** who sent me. **If anyone chooses to do **GOD’S** will, he will find out whether my teaching comes from **GOD** or whether I speak on my own.**”** (John 7:16-17)

“For I did not speak of my own accord, but the **FATHER** who sent me commanded me what to say and how to say it. I know that **HIS** command leads to eternal life. So whatever I say is just what the **FATHER** has told me to say.” (John 12:49-50)

“Jesus gave them this answer: I tell you the truth, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his **FATHER** doing, because whatever the **FATHER** does the Son also does... By myself I can do nothing; I judge only as I hear, and my judgment is just, for I seek not to please myself but **HIM** who sent me.” (John 5:19, 30)

“So Jesus said, When you have lifted up the Son of man, then you will know that I am the one I claim to be and that I do nothing of my own but speak just what the **FATHER** has taught me. The **ONE** who sent me is with me; **HE** has not left me alone, for I always do what pleases **HIM**.” (John 8:28-29)

“You heard me say, I am going away and I am coming back to you. If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the **FATHER**, for the **FATHER** is greater than I.” (John 14:28)

“Jesus said, Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet returned to the **FATHER**. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, I am returning to my **FATHER** and your **FATHER**, to my **GOD** and your **GOD**.” (John 20:17)

“The **GOD** of our fathers raised Jesus from the dead – whom you had killed by hanging him on a tree. **GOD** exalted him to **HIS** own right hand as Prince and Saviour that **HE** might give repentance and forgiveness of sins to Israel. We are witnesses of these things, and so is the Holy Spirit, whom **GOD** has given to those who obey **HIM**.” (Acts 5:30-32)

“Moreover, we have all had human fathers who disciplined us and we respected them for it. How much more should we submit to the **FATHER** of our spirits and live!” (Hebrews 12:9)

“After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: **FATHER**, the time has come. Glorify **YOUR** Son, that **YOUR** Son may glorify **YOU**. For **YOU** granted him authority over all people that he might give eternal life to all those **YOU** have given him. Now this is eternal life: that they may know **YOU, THE ONLY TRUE GOD**, and Jesus Christ, whom **YOU** have sent. I have brought **YOU** glory on earth by completing the work **YOU** gave me to do. And now **FATHER**, glorify me in **YOUR** presence with the glory I had with **YOU** before the world began.” (John 17:1-5)

“For us there is but One **GOD**, the **FATHER**, from **WHOM** all things came and for **WHOM** we live.” (1 Corinthians 8:6) [they changed the ending from “**we in HIM**,” (KJV), to “for whom we live”]

“But to us there is but One **GOD**, the **FATHER**, of **WHOM** are all things, and **we in HIM**.” (1 Corinthians 8:6 KJV)

“For in **HIM** we live and move and have our being, as some of your own poets have said, we are **HIS** offspring. Therefore since we are **GOD’S** offspring.” (Acts 18:28-29)

“One **GOD** and **FATHER** of all, **WHO** is over all and through all **and in all**.” (Ephesians 4:6) [they changed it from “**and in you all**” (KJV), “to and in all”]

“We know that we live in **HIM** and **HE** in us, because **HE** has given us of **HIS** Spirit.” (1 John 4:13)

“When all the people were being baptized, Jesus was baptized too. And as he was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended on him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: you are **MY** Son, whom **I** love; with you **I am** well pleased.” (Luke 3:21-22)

“You know what has happened throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached – how **GOD** anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because **GOD** was with him.” (Acts 10:37-38)

Jesus said, “Don’t you believe that I am in the **FATHER**, and the **FATHER** is in me? The words I say to you are not just my own. Rather, it is the **FATHER**, living in me, **WHO** is doing **HIS** work. Believe me when I say that I am in the **FATHER** and the **FATHER** is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves.” (John 14:10-11)

“Men of Israel, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by **GOD** to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which **GOD** did among you through him, as you yourselves know.” (Acts 2:22)

“My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the **FATHER** in our defense – Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world” (1 John 2:1-3)

“**GOD** presented him as a sacrifice of atonement, through faith in his blood.” (Romans 3:25)

“And the blood of Jesus, **HIS** Son, purifies us from all sin.” (1 John 1:7)

“Christ Jesus, who died – more than that, who was raised to life – is at the right hand of **GOD** and is also interceding for us.” (Romans 8:34)

“But because Jesus lives forever, he has a permanent priesthood. Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to **GOD** through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.” (Hebrews 7:24-25)

“For there is One **GOD** and one mediator between **GOD** and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all men.” (1 Timothy 2:5-6)

“Jesus answered them, Is it not written in your law, I have said you are gods

[“I said, you are gods; you are all sons of the **MOST HIGH**.” (Psalms 82:6)]

If **HE** called them gods, to whom the word of **GOD** came – and the scripture cannot be broken – what about the one whom the **FATHER** set apart as **HIS** very own and sent into the world? Why then do you accuse me of blasphemy because I said, I am **GOD’S** Son? (John 10:34-36)

“Jesus, Son of the **MOST HIGH GOD**.” (Mark 5:7)

“And so Jesus also suffered outside the city gate to make the people holy through his own blood.” (Hebrews 13:12)

“Both the one who makes men holy and those who are made holy are of the same family. So Jesus is not ashamed to call them brothers. He says, I will declare **YOUR** name to my brothers; in the presence of the congregation I will sing **YOUR** praises. And again, I will put my trust in **HIM**. And again he says, Here am I, and the children **GOD** has given me.” (Hebrews 2:11-13)

Jesus said, “I have revealed YOU to those whom YOU gave me out of the world. They were YOURS; YOU gave them to me and they have obeyed YOUR word. Now they know that everything YOU have given me comes from YOU. For I gave them the words YOU gave me and they accepted them. They knew with certainty that I came from YOU, and they believed that YOU sent me. I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those YOU have given me, for they are YOURS... My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, **THAT ALL OF THEM MAY BE ONE, FATHER,** just as YOU are in me and I in YOU. **MAY THEY ALSO BE IN US** so that the world may believe that YOU have sent me. I have given them the glory that YOU gave me, **THAT THEY MAY BE ONE AS WE ARE ONE: I IN THEM AND YOU IN ME.** May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that YOU sent me and have loved them even as YOU loved me. **FATHER,** I want those YOU have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory YOU have given me because YOU loved me before the creation of the world. Righteous **FATHER,** though the world does not know YOU, I know YOU, and they know that YOU have sent me. I have made YOU known to them, and will continue to make YOU known in order that the love YOU have for me may be in them and I myself may be in them.” (John 17:6-9,20-26)

“Holy **FATHER,** protect them by the power of YOUR name – the name you gave me – **SO THAT THEY MAY BE ONE AS WE ARE ONE.**” (John 17:11)

“And again, when **GOD** brings **HIS** firstborn into the world, **HE** says, Let all **GOD’S** angels worship him. In speaking of the angels **HE** says, **HE** makes his angels winds, his servants flames of fire. But about the Son **HE** says, Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever, and righteousness will be the scepter of your kingdom. You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; **therefore GOD, your GOD, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy.**” (Hebrews 1:6-9)

“Praise be to the **GOD** and **FATHER** of our Lord Jesus Christ, **WHO** has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. For **HE** chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in **HIS** sight. In love **HE** predestined us to be adopted as **HIS** sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with **HIS** pleasure and will to the praise of **HIS** glorious grace, which **HE** has freely given us in the One **HE** loves. In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of **GOD’S** grace... In him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of **HIM** who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of **HIS** will, in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of **HIS** glory. And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are **GOD’S** possession – to the praise of **HIS** glory.” (Ephesians 1:3-7, 11-14)

“what I am saying is that as long as the heir is a child, he is no different from a slave, although he owns the whole estate. He is subject to guardians and trustees until the time set by his **FATHER.** So also, when we were children, we were in slavery under the basic principles of the world. But when the time had fully come, **GOD** sent **HIS** Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those under the law, that we might receive the full rights of sons. Because you are sons, **GOD** sent the Spirit of **HIS** Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, **ABBA, FATHER.** So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, **GOD** has made you also an heir.” (Galatians 4:1-7)

“For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, **ABBA, FATHER.** The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are **GOD’S** children. Now if we are children, then we are heirs – heirs of **GOD** and co-heirs with Christ,

[“**HIS** Son, [“**HIS** firstborn”] whom **HE** appointed heir of all things.” (Hebrews 1:2)]

if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory. I consider that our present suffering are not worthy comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us. The creation waits in eager expectation for the sons of GOD to be revealed.” (Romans 8:15-19)

“For those GOD foreknew HE also predestined to be conformed to the likeness of HIS Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers.” (Romans 8:29)

“Although he was a Son, he learned obedience from what he suffered

[“In bringing many sons to glory, it was fitting that GOD, for WHOM and through WHOM everything exists, should make the author of their salvation perfect through suffering.” (Hebrews 2:10)]

and, once made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him and was designated by GOD to be high priest in the order of Melchizedek.” (Hebrews 5:8-10)

“But we ought always to thank GOD for you, brothers loved by the Lord, because from the beginning GOD chose you to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief of the truth. HE called you to this through our gospel, that you might share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.” (2 Thessalonians 2:13-14)

“His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as the light.” (Matthew 17:2)

“As the weeds are pulled up and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of the age. The Son of man will send out his angels, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that caused sin and all who do evil. They will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their FATHER. He who has ears, let him hear.” (Matthew 13:40-43)

“The sun has one kind of splendor, the moon another and the stars another; and star differs from star in splendor. So will it be with the resurrection of the dead.” (1 Corinthians 15:41-42)

“And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord’s glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever – increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.” (2 Corinthians 3:18)

“My dear children, for whom I am again in the pains of childbirth until Christ is formed in you.” (Galatians 4:19)

“When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.” (Colossians 3:4)

“When the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. He will punish those who do not know GOD and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the majesty of his power on the day he comes to be glorified in his holy people and to be marveled at among all those who have believed.” (2 Thessalonians 1:7-10)
